



## Destaging

- Once the parade concludes at City Park, all floats will be directed to keep heading south along Cedar St. and take a right on North St. (going past the library) and make their way back to the Community Center where they can be uninstalled/disassembled if needed.
- Please no destaging at City Park or the WHS parking lot due to all the activities happening at City Park directly after the parade
- All parade floats will need to be removed from Front St. before 5:00 PM to make room for citizen parking for the street dance.

## Parade Rules/Guidelines

- Drivers of motorized vehicles must possess a valid driver's license.
- Ensure vehicles have a sufficient amount of fuel for the entire duration of the parade (approximately 1.5 miles in distance or 45 minutes in total)
- Please drive SLOW (approximately 5 mph), and maintain a minimum distance of 30 feet from the unit ahead of you to ensure a smooth flow of the parade.
- Be ready to brake at any given moment.
- Music is allowed and encouraged as long as it does not disturb the floats around you.
- The possession or use of alcoholic beverages or tobacco products is prohibited in the assembly area and parade route for safety reasons.
- The safety of the participants on your float is your responsibility. Do not allow the individuals on your float to ride in an unsafe manner.
- Please only throw candy that is wrapped and will remain wrapped once it makes impact with the ground.
