Minnesota Main Street COVID Relief Grants to Begin Accepting Applications September 20th

Minnesota Department of Employment and Economic Development (DEED) will begin accepting applications for the Main Street COVID Relief Grants Program on September 20, 2021, closing September 30, 2021. A total of \$64.2 million is available in grants for Minnesota owned and operated businesses which can demonstrate financial hardship due to COVID. This includes for-profit, and non-profit organizations which earn revenue in ways similar to a business, with primary operations located in Minnesota.

Grant amounts are based on the number of full-time equivalent employees ranging between \$10,000 - \$25,000. Applicants which have not received assistance through previous relief programs will be prioritized for consideration. Grant funds received by individual businesses shall be used for working capital to support payroll expenses, rent, mortgage payments, utility bills, and other similar expenses that occur or have occurred since March 12, 2020, in the regular course of business. These are grants and no repayment will be required.
