City of Wabasso Regular Meeting Monday, November 14, 2022 Agenda Report

- 1. **Canvassing Board** See attached results. Per state law the council is to accept the local results of the general election.
- 2. **Public Hearing Delinquent Assessments** The assessment list has been whittled down to three delinquent accounts. I am still receiving payments and will bring the list to the council meeting.
- 3. EDA Minutes/Financial Reports enclosed
- 4. Violation Enforcement. I occasionally receive comments from residents relating to the enforcement of city ordinances most commonly public nuisances and animal complaints. Typically, I only actively enforce violations unless I have received a complaint, council direction or if there is a serious threat to public health, safety and welfare. I have also on occasion received comments that residents should not have to file a complaint in order for the city to act. I believe the process noted above is the most effective means of addressing violations and am asking you to review and affirm or have staff actively enforce violations without complaint.
- 5. Community Center Rental Rates Policy Non-Profits See attached memo.
- 6. **Boulevard Landscaping** A resident has requested that he replace the boulevard grass with landscaping rock. I've reviewed the city ordinances and it is clear that the city controls work within the right of way, but I could only find regulation of trees and "woody vegetation." Compounding this request is the property in question is located within the Cedar Street Improvement Project, and the plans and specifications approved by the council require the reseeding of the boulevards. The city also requires that owners keep their sidewalks "safe" that includes keeping them free of rocks. I wouldn't flag this if there was widespread use of landscaping rock in the boulevards, but in this instance, I feel the council should address it.
- 7. Golf Cart/ATV Ordinance Matt has not completed the final draft at this time.
- 8. Community Center Improvements Lion's Room Restrooms/Donation The Lion's Club has donated \$2,000 to the city and has requested it be used to paint the restrooms, replace the ceiling tiles and use any remaining monies to replace fixtures. I do not have estimates at this time but would request the Council authorize up to \$2,000 be spent on restroom upgrades. Jeff or I will contact you if additional funds are needed.
- 9. **USDA RD Engineering Agreement** The commitment letter requires that the City Council approve an engineering agreement with a consulting engineering firm to manage the Sewer Rehab Project. The actual agreement which is based on the standard USDA Agreement is very lengthy and consists of a lot of boilerplate language. I have attached a copy of relevant parts of the agreement. David Palm will be at the meeting to answer any questions.
- 10. **Budget Workshop** I will be updating the budget next week based on bills paid at the November Library Board, Council and EDA meetings. The city council has one regular meeting between the November regular meeting and the truth in taxation meeting that is on 12/19/22 at 6:00.
- 11. **Donation of Bethany Evangelical Lutheran Church Bell Tower and Cornerstone** Shirley Appel will be present to offer a donation of the Bethany ELC bell tower and cornerstone to be place in the City Cemetery. Note that the City Cemetery was originally owned and operated by Bethany ELC.
- 12. Cedar St. Pay Estimate No 2 Attached
- 13. USDA Conflict of Interest, Legal Services Agreement and Civil Rights Policy The USDA requires these documents and policies be adopted by the Council as part of the Sewer Rehab project. I have not received the documents at this time and will forward them to the council once received. I have attached an email and letter from Bond Counsel that has been reviewed by the USDA.

The meeting was called to order at 5:08 pm with board members Pat Eichten, Steve Burns, and Karl Guetter present. Also present were Matt Novak, Pat Dingels, and McKenzie Fischer.

The agenda was accepted but the budget review will be tabled until December's meeting when Larry will be present.

The minutes of the October 5, 2022 meeting were approved on a motion by Guetter, second by Burns. Eichten – Yes; Burns – Yes; Guetter – Yes.

Strategic Plan Update:

- Planning Committee has met twice so far and have the map put together.
- Planning Committee will be meeting again soon to work on zoning.
- Goblirsch Motors property
 - O Upon discovering the need for daycare, the EDA has considered building a daycare center in town. Pat Dingels found a program called Contamination Cleanup. This program would require a 25% match to clean up and turn around a property so long as it will bring jobs in. There is also a petroleum-based grant that could assist with the turnover of the Goblirsch Motors property. Guetter suggested bringing in Melanie Guetter to one of the next meetings to talk about the requirements with becoming a licensed day care provider. The board also discussed talking to current daycare providers to gather their opinions on the situation. We need more information and research on the subject before the board can continue any further. The board will stay in touch with Tim Goblirsch. Pat will look into the costs associated with doing inspections and environmental reviews.
 - The board also noted that the Bethany Lutheran Church is closing which could also be a potential opportunity for the EDA.

I am seeking direction from the council regarding how non profit groups should be charged for the use of the community center. I have not come across any policy regarding if and when Community Center rental fees should be charged to non-profits. Charging private parties goes without saying. At this time I do not charge other governmental bodies, such as the EDA, Library Board, Vail Township, etc. Also, the Lion's Club and Legion are not charged for their activities. I have been asked by political parties to waive the fees and I have denied the request. I also get requests from the county, churches and other governmental organizations to hold meetings or fundraisers. Recently I received a request from a group that wishes to start a county 4H and would like to hold an organizational meeting. My sense is that they should not be charged, but I don't believe I should waive the fee without receiving direction from the city. Some things to keep in mind:

- a. Some organizations have deeper pockets than others.
- b. Organizations serve differing clientele for example I always have a soft heart for organizations that serve the youth.
- c. Some organizations exclusively serve residents of Wabasso and others serve a large area.
- d. Some uses require a lot of cleaning others you can't even tell the room was used.
- e. By waiving fees you run the risk of displacing a "paying customer".

Enclosed is the Compliance Evaluation Inspection (CEI) Report and Letter of Warning (LOW) that resulted from an inspection of the city of Wabasso Wastewater Treatment Facility on September 22, 2022, by Taylor Olson of the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA).

The CEI consisted of a discussion with Wastewater Operators Kerwin Armitage and Jim Jenniges, a visual inspection of the plant, and a review of Monthly Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) for the time period of November 1, 2019, through July 31, 2022. Based on the results of the CEI, five effluent limit violations of the terms and conditions set forth in the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES)/State Disposal System (SDS) permit were documented as alleged. Please see the CEI Report and LOW for further detail.

Please be aware, this correspondence does not preclude the MPCA from taking further action in response to noncompliance identified.
